

2009 KLOUDBusters Launch Schedule

The tentative 2009 Launch Schedule follows. With the newly adopted TRA Research Rules. all Tripoli members over 18 years of age may participate at Research launches. These changes allow us to reduce the number of launch days throughout the year but still gives all KLOUDBusters who are TRA members the chance to participate at about the same level as before. This schedule compression is our attempt to reduce the demands on the Prefect other and club members who set-up and conduct small launches during the off-

peak (i.e. cold) months. You'll see these launch days listed

as "Combined" on the schedule. If your kids want to come out and fly their rockets during these "Combined" weekends and you're a TRA member, come out and put your name on the flight card for each launch.

We're also adding a new 2-day "Sweaty Balls 1" Research launch during July in place of the regular July Fun Fly. This gives the ever-growing Research crowd a chance to have their own 2-day Research opportunity and with the new rules, the TRA member folks who want to fly commercial motors can still come out and do so.

The format for AIRFest 19 changes a little with Friday now a "Combined" launch day. This supports the higher ratio of adult/TRA flyers vs. kids/non-TRA flyers who typically attend AIRFest. Bookend Research opportunities at AIRFest sounds intriguing, doesn't it?

One additional note on the schedule ... the FAA has published a new set of rules that govern our waivers for rocket launches as of December 4, 2008 and which go into affect the early part of February 2009. These changes will undoubtedly require changes to the waiver in its existing format, and those changes aren't 100% clear right now. The flow time required make it **VERY UNLIKELY** that the new waiver will be in place for the January Fun Fly and possibly even the February Fun Fly will be affected as well. Please monitor the Yahoo e-group and/or the KLOUDBusters web site to obtain the current status of each of these launches. As soon as we know something definitive, we will let everyone know.
