The annual KLOUDBusters Board of Director Election (KBoD) ballot is enclosed with this newsletter. We are electing the Prefect, President, Treasurer, and (1) Member-at-Large for 2010-2011.

The members of the KBoD handle the business dealings, policies, and scheduling for the Club. KBoD members must be KLOUDBusters members in good standing. The term of office is for two (2) years, except for Prefect, who is elected every year.

## 2010 KLOUDBusters Launch Schedule

The 2010 Launch Schedule follows. The launches on this year's launch are the same format we had in 2009 with single-day Research/Combined launches during the off-peak months.

For all Research/Combined launches, Tripoli members over 18 years of age may participate and certification flights are allowed. Commercial or research motors are allowed, but remember – all certification attempts must be made on commercial motors.

We will reprise the 2-day Research-only **Sweaty Balls** launch during July. Sweaty Balls I certainly lived up to its name and those participating had a great time with some extreme rocketry and rocket pasture antics. We're hoping to draw in even more flyers from surrounding clubs who enjoy the opportunity for Research rocketry and as waiver altitudes around the country are being decreased.

Please be aware, the FAA waiver altitude for all 2010 KLOUDBusters launches will be 34,500 MSL, which is a slight modification to our waiver altitude in past years. With a launch site elevation of about 1,300', our waiver limit for 2010 will be 33,200' AGL.

## February Fun Fly

The next fun fly is scheduled for February 13, 2010 and is a Research rules launch.
